Sorry I splashed water on you, but you could have moved.



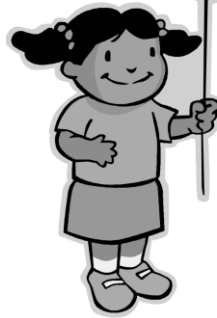
Sorry I ate your cookie, but the milk is good.
